


Immigration Removal Centre Gatwick

Brennan Williams Lester were invited by BAA Lynton to design a new Immigration Removal Centre to RIBA stage C Gatwick Airport for the UK Immigration Service. It was then passed on to the Immigration Service for completion by the construction consortium before becoming the subject of a competition leading to the appointment of a private sector operator.

The complex is a 393-bed facility designed to cat C standards complete with UKIS and Operators accommodation, Visits and Visitors facilities, Education and Religious facilities, Kitchen and Maintenance.

The design had restrictions on the height of the buildings which by necessity had to be kept below the airport radar scanner working levels.
