



Hilton's Great Western Royal Hotel sits over Paddington Station in the heart of London. Originally designed by Isambard Kingdom Brunel in the 1840's, the project was first renovated in the 1930's and more recently at the turn of the century and millenium.

Having a Grade II listing led to a series of design challenges for team members working on this highly complicated 460 bedroom hotel renovation for the Costain-Skanska Joint Venture. The project contract sum was awarded at £46 million over an eighte en month period.
